NEW YORK, SEPTEMBER 22, 2020 (revised 10.09.20) – Winners in Documentary Television Programming for the 41th Annual News and Documentary Emmy® Awards were announced today by The National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences (NATAS). The News & Documentary Emmy Awards were presented as two individual ceremonies this year: categories honoring Documentaries were presented tonight. Yesterday, Monday, September 21st, 2020, categories honoring Television News Programming were presented. Both ceremonies were live-streamed on our dedicated platform powered by Vimeo.

"Tonight, we proudly honored the outstanding professionals that make up the Documentary Television Programming categories of the 41st Annual News & Documentary Emmy® Awards," said Adam Sharp, President & CEO, NATAS. "As we continue to rise to the challenge of presenting a 'live' ceremony during Covid-19 with hosts, presenters and accepters all coming from their homes via the 'virtual technology' of the day, we continue to honor those that provide us with the necessary tools and information we need to make the crucial decisions that these challenging and unprecedented times call for."

Tonight's ceremony was hosted by three distinguished documentarians: Lynn Novick, creator of more than 80 hours of programming with Ken Burns, Dawn Porter, award-winning documentary filmmaker, Trilogy Films, and David Fanning, founder, and executive producer at large, FRONTLINE.
