The News & Documentary Emmy® Awards will be presented in two individual ceremonies:

- -News Categories Wednesday, September 28th, 2022 at 7:30 p.m. EDT
- -Documentary Categories Thursday, September 29th, 2022 at 7:30 p.m. EDT

Each ceremony will be presented live at the Palladium Times Square in New York City, and will be streamed live on NATAS' dedicated viewing platform powered by Vimeo, available on the web at watch.theemmmys.tv and via The Emmys® apps for iOS, tvOS, Android, FireTV, and Roku (full list at apps.theemmys.tv).

To purchase tickets to attend the event:

- 1. To order premium tickets for the September 28th News ceremony, regardless of method of payment, please complete an order request form <u>HERE</u>.
- If you are ordering standard tickets for either night (9/28 News Ceremony and or 9/29 Doc Ceremony) and need to be invoiced, please complete an order request form HERE. If you are paying by credit card, you may order your tickets HERE.

Please note: all seating for the event will be handled by our Ticketing Team. We will do everything in our power to keep individuals and companies seated together. In order to make the ceremony move swiftly, we want to have all the potential acceptors seated in the front. Therefore, for the News ceremony, we strongly recommend any potential award acceptors to order premium tickets. This is not necessary for attendees of the documentary ceremony as there is a single price ticket for that event.

All ticket sales must be completed by Friday, September 2nd, 2022 by 6:00pm Eastern. All orders will be locked at that time and all reservations/sales will be considered final. There will be no refunds for unused seats.

All tickets will be available for pick-up on the day of the ceremony at the ticket box office window at the Palladium. If you have an individual who will be picking up a block of tickets, please note that when you are placing your order.

NATAS COVID-19 Policy for ALL ATTENDEES

NATAS will refuse entry to any attendee who is unable to meet the requirements of this policy and no refunds will be granted.

Each attendee must provide proof of either:

Full vaccination against the SARS-CoV-2 virus, including a single booster (if eligible);

OR

• A negative result on a PCR-based molecular test that was administered <u>no earlier than:</u> 12:01am PDT on Monday, September 26, 2022

NATAS will be using **CLEAR®** to provide easy proof of required COVID-related health certification for faster entry to the event. CLEAR® is widely used in the sports and entertainment world for this process.

To avoid delays, please do not wait to start the process. All attendees should be encouraged to download the **CLEAR®** app (<u>Android</u> or <u>Apple</u> devices) on their phones as soon as possible, if they don't already have it.

- After opening the CLEAR app, click on Health Pass. In the field "Have a code?" enter NATAS. Next, you will be asked to choose an event in the dropdown menu. You should pick either:
 - News (9/28) News & Documentary Emmys
 - Docs (9/29) News & Documentary Emmys

Follow the instructions from that point on.

- If attendee is vaccinated, they should upload their vaccination information at that time.
 Avoid any technical problems by not waiting till the day before or day of event to do this step.
- In order to activate your pass on the day of the event, attendees will be required to complete a short health survey via the CLEAR app within 24 hours of the ceremony. This will trigger a green Health Pass which allows entry.
